5. The provision of personal data is voluntary but necessary so that we can inform you about the Programme.

The recipients of the data contained in the form may be the entities providing and supporting IT systems used by epruf rozliczenia sp. z o.o., website hosting providers and providers of website analytics and data storage tools, as well as other entities providing services to epruf rozliczenia sp. z o.o. related to its current operations
7. Your data will be processed by us until we send you information about the Programme and will then be deleted.
8. Data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations.
9. You have the right, within the scope of the provisions of the Regulation, to request access to your data, to request its rectification, to request its erasure, to request the restriction of its processing and to object to the processing of your personal data.
10. In case of doubts related to the processing of personal data, you can ask us for information. Irrespective of the above, everyone has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
